- First clinic was held in 2015

# TYPICAL CLINIC DAY



- Clinic hours:
  - Selected Saturdays 8:30AM-12:30PM
  - Selected Tuesdays, 5:00PM-9:00PM
- Staffing:
  - 2 KCU Student-Run Clinic Directors
  - 2 Student doctors per physician
  - 2 scribes per physician
- What Happens
  - Scribe & Student Doctor pair up to take vitals & interview patient
  - Physician meets with pair to discuss patient information
  - Physician examines patient with students
  - Physician debriefs case with students to develop differential diagnoses and prescribe relevant medications

- Provide advice on how to work with real patients as physicians
  - Teach how to think critically through clinical cases
  - Begin a career in teaching and academics
  - If not in primary care, you can provide a new perspective on patient care
  - Students look up to physicians and value the one-on-one attention
